Peter A. Gallagher is the Senior Vice President for Technology and Solutions within the National Security and Innovative Solutions Sector of CACI International.

Prior to joining CACI, Major General (Retired) Gallagher served as the Director of the Network Cross-Functional Team within Army Futures Command, responsible for innovation and modernization the Army's network to enable Joint All Domain Command and Control (JADC2). He was previously the Director of Architecture, Operations, Networks, and Space in the Army Chief Information Officer/G-6; responsible for strategy, policy and guidance to enable mission command across the Army's Global Enterprise Network.

Commissioned as a Distinguished Military Graduate from Pittsburg State University, he holds a bachelor's degree in Mathematics and a master's degree in National Security Strategy from the National Defense University. He spent most of his career providing communications support to Conventional and Special Operations Forces throughout the world.

Recent staff assignments included Deputy Director of the Joint Staff Pakistan-Afghanistan Coordination Cell, International Security and Assistance Force-Afghanistan CJ-6, Executive Officer to the CIO/G-6, and Director, Chief Information Officer (CIO)/J-6 in United States Central Command (US CENTCOM).

He has commanded Soldiers at the Platoon, Company, Troop, Battalion, Squadron, and Brigade, and Army Direct Reporting Unit levels. His command assignments include United States Special Operations Command (USSOCOM) units including Commander of the Joint Communications Unit, Battalion Commander for the 112th Signal Battalion, Squadron Commander of a Special Mission Unit. He also served as the Brigade Commander for Defense Information Systems Agency (DISA) Central Field Command. He later served as Deputy Commanding General and Commanding General for the Army's global IT service provider, the Network Enterprise Technology Command (NETCOM).
